

**DECISION 12/2020 OF THE DIRECTOR OF
THE EUROPEAN INSTITUTE OF INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY (EIT)**

ON THE SCHEDULE OF PUBLIC HOLIDAYS FOR THE EIT FOR THE YEAR 2021

THE EUROPEAN INSTITUTE OF INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 294/2008 of 11 March 2008 establishing the European Institute of Innovation and Technology¹, as amended by (EU) No 1292/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013² (hereinafter, "EIT Regulation"), in particular, Section 4 (3) (a) and (i) of the Annex of the EIT Regulation;

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities, laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, EURATOM, ECSC) No 259/68 (hereinafter "the Staff Regulations" and "the CEOS"), both as latest amended by Regulation (EU, EURATOM) No 1023/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 October 2013³; and in particular Article 61 of the Staff Regulations, Article 16 and 91 of the CEOS thereof;

Having regard to the Decision of the Governing Board of 27 December 2013 on the adoption of Implementing Rules to the Staff Regulations, and in particular, the Commission Decision of 16 December 2013 on leave⁴;

Having regard to the Commission Decision of 2 March 2020 on public holidays for 2021 for the institutions of the European Union⁵.

WHEREAS

- (1) The EIT attempts to adapt its working calendar to the local conditions in Hungary, while taking as a reference the schedule of public holidays at the European Commission (Commission Decision 2020/C 69/05 of 2 March 2020 on public holidays for 2021 for the institutions of the European Union).
